Archbishop Carlson has a love to keep Catholic schools open.

There is a program called Alive In Christ which is a program aimed at helping pay for low income families for their children to attend Catholic schools. In 2013 the Roman Catholic Foundation set up endowments to help fund Catholic education.

Father T. requested that MMOC be included in the third of three blocks of parishes to participate in the "Beyond Sunday" fundraiser.

This is a 5 year pledge program.

60% of funds raised go to the Roman Catholic Foundation for distribution of educational programs.

40% of funds raised stays at the local parish for their determination of distribution. Primary purpose is to help the middle class with Catholic education costs.

The assigned goal is \$820,000.

5 year pledges to meet this goal.

Heather is the foundation support person assigned to MMOC.

Specific steps and stages are given for this fundraising effort.
